The Commissioners' Court of Taylor County met in Regular Session on April 8, 2025, with the following members present:

1. **Judge Crowley convened the Court in open session at 9:00 a.m.**

2. **Invocation and Pledge**

3. **Consider approval of Minutes and Adopt the Agenda.**
