

## Taylor County Commissioners' Court

November 22, 2016

The Commissioners' Court of Taylor County met in Special Session on November 22, 2016, with the following members present:

1. Judge Downing A. Bolls Jr., County Judge
2. Randy Williams, Commissioner, Precinct 1
3. Kyle Kendrick, Commissioner, Precinct 2
4. Chuck Statler, Commissioner, Precinct 4

When the following motions were heard:

1. Judge Bolls convened the Court in open session at 10:00 a.m.

2. Commissioner Statler made a motion to adopt the agenda for the meeting of November 22, 2016 noting that the wording "Constitutional Amendment" in item #3 be changed to "General". The motion was seconded by Commissioner Kendrick and carried unanimously.

3. Freda Ragan, Elections Administrator presented the results of the General Election held on November 8, 2016. She included the cumulative results as well as the votes broken down by vote center. A total of 46,874 votes were cast; of that ballots cast during early voting were 33,837 and 13,037 ballots were cast on Election Day. A total of 59% of eligible voters cast their votes. 104 Reasonable Impediment documents were turned in by voters who couldn't produce photo identification; these are forwarded to the Secretary of State. Commissioner Statler made a motion to approve the Canvass of the ballots from the November 8, 2016 general election and accept the results. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Williams and carried unanimously. [Exhibit]

4. Freda Ragan, Elections Administrator presented the results of the Bond Election held during the General Election of November 8, 2016. There were 29,280 votes cast in favor and against 11,601 were cast; the totals included both on Election Day and early voting. Judge Bolls called the roll of the Commissioners' Court. All members of the Court were present except Commissioner Egger. Judge Bolls read the Order Canvassing Returns and Declaring Results of the November 8, 2016 Bond Election; and Containing Provisions Necessary and Incidental Thereto. He also stated that Commissioner Egger, who was not at the meeting, had signed an Acknowledgment of Notice of Meeting for Absentees. Commissioner Williams made a motion to adopt the Order Canvassing Returns and Declaring Results of the November 8, 2016 Bond Election; and Containing Provisions Necessary and Incidental Thereto. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Kendrick and carried unanimously. [Exhibit]


