March 21, 2017

The Commissioners' Court of Taylor County met in Regular Session on March 21, 2017, with the following members present:

When the following motions were heard:

1. Judge Bolls convened the Court in open session at 10:00 a.m.

2. Commissioner Statler gave the invocation and Commissioner Statler led the Court in the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag of the United States of America.

3. Commissioner Birchum made a motion to approve the minutes for the meeting of March 7, 2017 and to adopt the agenda for the meeting of March 21, 2017 as printed and posted. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Williams and carried unanimously.

6. Consider approval of the February 2017 Treasurers' Report and any appropriate action.

County Treasurer Lesa Crosswhite presented the Treasurer's report for the month ending February 28, 2017 noting changes in account balances and interest rates. Commissioner Statler made a motion to approve the February Treasurer's Report. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Kendrick and carried unanimously. [Exhibit]

7. Consider approval of the Taylor County Historical Commission 2017-2018 Member Roster and any appropriate action.

Judge Bolls made a motion that the Commissioners Court approve the list of membership of the Taylor County Historical Commission. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Williams and carried unanimously. [Exhibit]

8. Consider approval of preliminary plat of Rafter T Subdivision located in Precinct 3 and any appropriate action.

Commissioner Birchum submitted the preliminary plat for the proposed subdivision which is off Hwy 83 in Tuscola adjacent CR 128. Commissioner Birchum made a motion to approve the preliminary plat of the Rafter T subdivision. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Kendrick and carried unanimously. [Exhibit]

9. Discuss and consider purchase of Priefert Equipment for the Taylor County Expo Center Bond through the TIPS Purchasing Coop and any appropriate action.

Scott Henderson Purchasing Agent recommended using TIPS for the purchase from Priefert, because previous purchases from Priefert of like equipment would ensure that the stalls and panels match. Commissioner Kendrick made a motion to purchase the Priefert Equipment for the Taylor County Expo Center Bond through the TIPS Purchasing Coop. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Statler and carried unanimously. [Exhibit]

10. Discuss Interlocal Agreement with Brazos County to participate in ITB 2013-104 Jail Pharmaceuticals contract and any appropriate action.

Scott Henderson Purchasing Agent reported Brazos would be the second Texas County to use Taylor County's contract for jail pharmaceuticals. Commissioner Kendrick made a motion to approve the Interlocal agreement with Brazos County to participate in ITB 2013-104 Jail Pharmaceuticals contract. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Birchum and carried unanimously. [Exhibit]

11. Consider award of ITB 2017-101 Food Products at the Juvenile Justice Center and any appropriate action.

Scott Henderson Purchasing Agent reported one bid was received and recommended award to that vendor Ben E. Keith. Commissioner Williams made a motion to award ITB 2017-101 Food Products at the Juvenile Justice Center as presented. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Kendrick and carried unanimously.
