

Taylor County Commissioners' Court

October 11, 2017

The Commissioners' Court of Taylor County met in Regular Session on October 11, 2017, with the following members present:

1. Judge Downing A. Bolls Jr., County Judge
2. Randy Williams, Commissioner, Precinct 1
3. Brad Birchum, Commissioner, Precinct 3

When the following motions were heard:

1. Judge Bolls convened the Court in open session at 9:00 a.m.

2. County Auditor Elijah Anderson explained a recent Attorney General Opinion requires Commissioners' Courts to approve payroll expenditures as if they were a regular accounts payable expense. Beginning October 1, 2017 the Auditor and Treasurer's Office will submit each item of payroll including payments for insurance along with other benefits and expenses associated with payroll. He will from time to time include other regular accounts payable items whose due date would expire before the next regularly scheduled accounts payable report.

Commissioner Williams made a motion to approve the payroll and bills as presented according to the minutes of the accounts. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Birchum and carried unanimously. [Exhibit]


3. Sheriff Bishop presented a proposed agreement between Taylor and Jones County to house Taylor County inmates in Jones County at a rate of \$45.00 per day. He noted he would transfer 5 inmates once the agreement is approved.

Commissioner Williams made a motion to approve the Interlocal Agreement between Jones County and Taylor County as presented by Sheriff Bishop. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Birchum and carried unanimously. [Exhibit]
