When the following motions were heard:

1. Judge Bolls convened the Court in open session at 9:00 a.m. and declared the meeting was to conduct a public hearing on the proposed budget and tax rate as well as a Special Called Meeting of the Commissioners' Court to discuss budget matters.

2. Public Hearing on FY20 Budget and Tax Rate

Commissioner Statler made a motion to convene in a public hearing. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Williams and carried unanimously.

No member of the public spoke during the public hearing.

Commissioner Williams made a motion to close the public hearing. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Birchum and carried unanimously.

3. Call meeting to order and adopt agenda

Commissioner Kendrick made a motion to convene in a Special Called Meeting. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Williams and carried unanimously.


Commissioner Birchum made a motion to adopt the agenda. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Kendrick and carried unanimously.


The Court took no actions nor made motions.
