- 10. Discuss and consider extending Taylor County Office Operations due to COVID-19 spread and imminent threat to public health and safety of our community and employees and any appropriate action



11. Declare Salvage Property and any appropriate action


Commissioner Birchum made a motion to declare the property as salvage as presented. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Williams and carried unanimously. [Exhibit]
