3. The Court conducted budget hearings; recessing and reconvening as necessary.


4. Judge Bolls recessed the Court at approximately 2:00 p.m. on Monday June, 15, 2020.


5. Judge Bolls called the Court to order at 8:30 a.m. on Tuesday, June 16, 2020.
