The Commissioners' Court of Taylor County met in Regular Session on February 23, 2021, with the following members present:

When the following motions were heard:

1. Judge Bolls convened the Court in open session at 9:00 a.m.

2. Andy Penny, Area Director of Fellowship of Christian Athletes gave the invocation and Commissioner Statler led the Court in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flags of the United States of America and the State of Texas.

3. Commissioner Kendrick made a motion to approve the minutes of the meeting held on February 2, 2021 and to adopt the agenda for the meeting of February 23, 2021 as printed and posted. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Williams and carried unanimously.
