May 25, 2021

The Commissioners' Court of Taylor County met in Regular Session on May 25, 2021, with the following members present:

When the following motions were heard:

1. Judge Bolls convened the Court in open session at 9:00 a.m.

2. John Shepherd, Pastor of North Park Assembly of God gave the invocation and Commissioner Birchum led the Court in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flags of the United States of America and the State of Texas.

3. Commissioner Birchum made a motion to approve the minutes of the meetings held on May 11, 2021 Emergency and Regular sessions and to adopt the agenda for the meeting of May 25, 2021 as printed and posted. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Williams and carried unanimously.

20. RECONVENE in Open Session and any appropriate action.


