January 4, 2022

The Commissioners' Court of Taylor County met in Regular Session on January 4, 2022, with the following members present:

At which the following motions were heard:

1. Judge Bolls convened the Court in open session at 9:00 a.m.

2. Blake Hill, Pastor of Beltway Park Church gave the invocation and Commissioner Williams led the Court in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flags of the United States of America and the State of Texas.

3. Commissioner Kendrick made a motion to approve the minutes of the meeting held on December 21, 2021 and to adopt the agenda for the meeting of January 4, 2022 as printed and posted. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Birchum and carried unanimously.

8. Consider approval of FY 2022 renewal of the County Clerk & District Clerk Offices Crime Policy and any appropriate action

Commissioner Statler made a motion to approve the renewal of the County Clerk Office's Crime Policy and Bond. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Birchum and carried unanimously. [Exhibit]

Commissioner Williams made a motion to approve the FY 2022 District Clerk Office's Crime Policy. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Kendrick and carried unanimously. [Exhibit]

9. Consider approval of transferring Auction Proceeds of \$78,300 from Surplus Patrol vehicles sold in Auction to the Sheriff's Budget Line 9010 to purchase 2 pickups for CID and any appropriate action

Commissioner Williams made a motion to reimburse the self-insurance fund \$9,100.00 with the remainder of the funds going to the Sheriff's Department Budget line item. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Birchum. The vote passed on a vote of 4-1 with Commissioner Kendrick casting a vote against the motion. [Exhibit]

10. Discuss and consider unspent budget pertaining to salaries at the Sheriff's Office and any appropriate action

11. Consider setting a Public Hearing January 18, 2021 to consider a request to abandon a dedicated right of way easement in Summerhill Estates, Lots 1-3 and any appropriate action

Commissioner Kendrick made a motion to set the Public Hearing for January 18, 2022 to consider the request of abandonment received from Mr. Brazell and Mr. Smith. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Birchum and carried unanimously. [Exhibit]
