RESOLUTION 07-23/24

Order Allowing the Development Corporation of Abilene, Inc. to Exercise its Powers in the Extra-Territorial Jurisdiction of the City of Abilene

WHEREAS, Petrosmith Equipment, LP (the "Company") is located within the extra-territorial jurisdiction of the City of Abilene, Taylor County, Texas (the "Abilene ETJ in Taylor County") and has and may in the future apply for an economic incentive from the Development Corporation of Abilene, Inc. ("DCOA"); and

WHEREAS, according to Texas Local Government Code 501.159, the DCOA has requested that Taylor County give its approval to the DCOA to exercise its powers within the Abilene ETJ in Taylor County by allowing the Company, which is within the Abilene ETJ in Taylor County, to receive an economic incentive from the DCOA; and

WHEREAS, Taylor County desires to give the DCOA such approval; and


WHEREAS, the DCOA's economic incentives are funded in their entirety by the DCOA and no funding is required or expected under the program from Taylor County.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED that the Commissioners Court of Taylor County hereby:

1. Approves of the DCOA exercising its powers within the Abilene ETJ in Taylor County by allowing the Company, which is located within the Abilene ETJ in Taylor County, to receive an economic incentive from the DCOA; and
2. Authorizes Taylor County to take all necessary actions to effect this Resolution.


