RESOLUTION 08-23/24

A RESOLUTION OF THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF TAYLOR COUNTY, TEXAS APPOINTING A HEALTH AUTHORITY AND MEDICAL DIRECTOR FOR THE ABILENE-TAYLOR COUNTY PUBLIC HEALTH DISTRICT AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OF CITY OF ABILENE TO ENTER INTO A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH DR. GARY HOLLAND AS THE HEALTH AUTHORITY AND MEDICAL DIRECTOR.

WHEREAS, the Local Public Health Reorganization Act, Chapter 121, Texas Health and Safety Code provides that a governing body of a municipality or the commissioner's court of a county may enforce any law that is reasonably necessary to protect the public health; and

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene, Texas and Taylor County, Texas, have created the Abilene-Taylor County Public Health District to provide public health services in this region; and

WHEREAS, a Health Authority is a physician appointed under the terms of the Local Public Health Reorganization Act to administer state and local laws relating to public health within the appointing body's jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, a Health Authority must be a competent physician with a reputable professional standing who is legally qualified to practice medicine in the state of Texas, and be a resident of the state of Texas, and

WHEREAS, the Health Authority shall serve a term of two years and may be appointed to successive terms;

WHEREAS, Dr. Gary Holland meets the qualifications to be appointed as the Health Authority and as the Medical Director of the Abilene-Taylor County Public Health District; and

WHEREAS, the Abilene City Council is considering approval of Dr. Gary Holland as the Health Authority of the Abilene-Taylor County Public Health District.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF TAYLOR COUNTY, TEXAS:

PART 1. That Dr. Gary Holland is appointed as the Health Authority for the region covered by the Abilene-Taylor County Public Health District, and shall serve a term of two years.


PART 2. That Dr. Gary Holland is appointed as the Medical Director for the Abilene-Taylor County Public Health District.


