Phil Crowley was born at Dyess Air Force Base, grew up in Abilene, and graduated from AISD. Phil graduated from Hardin-Simmons University where he currently is also an adjunct professor each semester. Phil then graduated from Texas Wesleyan School of Law (now Texas A&M School of Law) in Fort Worth. Phil moved back home and was in private practice for a year and half after passing the Bar. Phil joined the Taylor County District Attorney's Office in 2015 and became a felony prosecutor in 2017. Phil remained a felony prosecutor until January 1, 2023 when he was sworn in as Taylor County Judge after winning the Republican Nomination for that Office in March, 2022 and running unopposed in the November, 2022 General Election. Phil attends Beltway Park Church, is on the Abilene Chamber of Commerce Board of Directors, Abilene Regional Growth Alliance Board of Directors, Alliance for Women and Children Executive Board, Betty Hardwick Behavioral Advisory Team, Metropolitan Planning Commission, Taylor County Child Advocacy Center Board, Taylor County Historical Commission, Taylor County Venue District Board, Texas Tech Health Sciences Center Community Advisory Board, and West Texas Council of Governments Executive Board.
