WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the Taylor County Commissioners' Court that state funds are available for the Juvenile Probation Department through the Criminal Justice Division, Office of the Governor of the State of Texas; and,

WHEREAS, the Taylor County Commissioners' Court finds it in the best interest if the citizens of Taylor County, that the "Purchase of Juvenile Services" Program be operated for the state fiscal year of 2026; and

*WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the Taylor County Commissioners' Court that the Juvenile Probation Department is applying for state funds in the amount of **\$ 22,400** through the Criminal Justice Division of the Office of the Governor of the State of Texas for the "Purchase of Juvenile Services" Program ; and*

WHEREAS, the Taylor County Commissioners' Court has agreed that the acceptance of these funds would be in the best interest of the citizens of Taylor County; and

WHEREAS, the Taylor County Commissioners, Court has agreed that in the event of a loss or misuse of the Criminal Justice Division funds, Taylor County Commissioners' Court assures that the funds will be returned to the Criminal Justice Division in full.

WHEREAS, the Taylor County Commissioners' Court will secure and renew fidelity bond covering the full amount of CJD funds upon acceptance of any grant award.

WHEREAS, the Taylor County Commissioners' Court designates Phil Crowley, Taylor County Judge, as the grantee's authorizing official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate the grant on behalf of the applicant agency.

WHEREAS, said motion passed;

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED: that the Juvenile Probation Department of Taylor County be is hereby authorized to apply for funding from the Criminal Justice Division of the Office of the Governor of the State of Texas for "Purchase of Juvenile Services" Program.


