RESOLUTION TO ADOPT USE OF HART INTERCIVIC VERITY VOTING 2.7 SYSTEM

WHEREAS, on July 23, 2019, the Taylor County Commissioners Court voted to purchase Verity Voting 2.3 Voting System from Hart Intercivic, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, on March 29, 2022, the Hart Verity Voting 2.3 system from Hart Intercivic was upgraded to the Hart Verity Duo Voting 2.5 system, a voting system that will use, create, or display a paper record that may be read by the voter pursuant to Section 129.003 of the Texas Election Code; and

WHEREAS, on August 24, 2023, the Secretary of State certified for use in Texas elections Hart Intercivic's Verity Voting 2.7 system; and


WHEREAS the Taylor County Elections Administrator desires to upgrade from the current Verity Voting 2.5 system to the updated Verity Scan 2.7.6, Verity Data 2.7.5, Verity Build 2.7.5, Verity Count 2.7.1, Verity Central 2.7.7, Verity Controller 2.7.2, and Verity Touch Writer Duo 2.7.2; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 123.001(b) of the Texas Election Code, Taylor County must formally adopt said voting system.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF TAYLOR COUNTY, TEXAS THAT:

Taylor County does hereby adopt the Hart Intercivic Verity Version 2.7 voting system, as certified by the State of Texas, to be used for early and regular Election Day voting by Taylor County for the November 4, 2025, election and all subsequent elections held thereafter.

PASSED AND APPROVED ON this 20th day of May 2025.


