A RESOLUTION BY THE TAYLOR COUNTY COMMISSIONERS COURT CERTIFYING COMPLETION OF FY2025 CYBERSECURITY MANDATED TRAINING OF ALL COUNTY EMPLOYEES


WHEREAS, Section 2054.5191 of the Government Code requires local governments to identify local government employees, elected officials, and appointed officials who have access to a local government computer system or database and use a computer to perform at least 25 percent of the employee's or official's required duties to complete, at least once a year, cybersecurity training certified under Section 2054.519; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners' Court of Taylor County has verified by evidence and certificates that all Taylor County employees and officials covered by Section 2054.5191 have completed the cybersecurity training required by Section 2054.519 for fiscal year 2025 and required periodic audits to ensure compliance with Section 2054.5191.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE TAYLOR COUNTY COMMISSIONERS' COURT IN ABILENE, TEXAS, hereby certifies and verifies that Taylor County's employees and officials covered by Section 2054.5191 have completed the certified Cybersecurity training required by Section 2054.519 for fiscal year 2025 and that, therefore, Taylor County is fully compliant with Sections 2054.519 and 2054.5191 of the Government Code.
